Schools may apply for Erasmus+: Key Action 1 funding for their teachers to attend courses in the UK.  
(Individual teachers may no longer apply for grants.)

**Deadline: 16 March 2014** for courses starting **1 July 2014 – 30 June 2015** (Only 1 deadline for the year.)

Schools should first register on-line to obtain a Personal Identification Code (PIC) number for the school.  
Applications for funding should then be made on-line to applicants' National Agency for Erasmus+ by 16 March 2014.

(Erasmus+ replaces the Lifelong Learning Programme: Comenius and Grundtvig.)
