Deadline: 16 March 2014 for courses starting 1 July 2014 – 30 June 2015 (Only 1 deadline for the year.)

Schools should first register on-line to obtain a Personal Identification Code (PIC) number for the school. Applications for funding should then be made on-line to applicants' National Agency for Erasmus+ by 16 March 2014.

(Erasmus+ replaces the Lifelong Learning Programme: Comenius and Grundtvig.)
